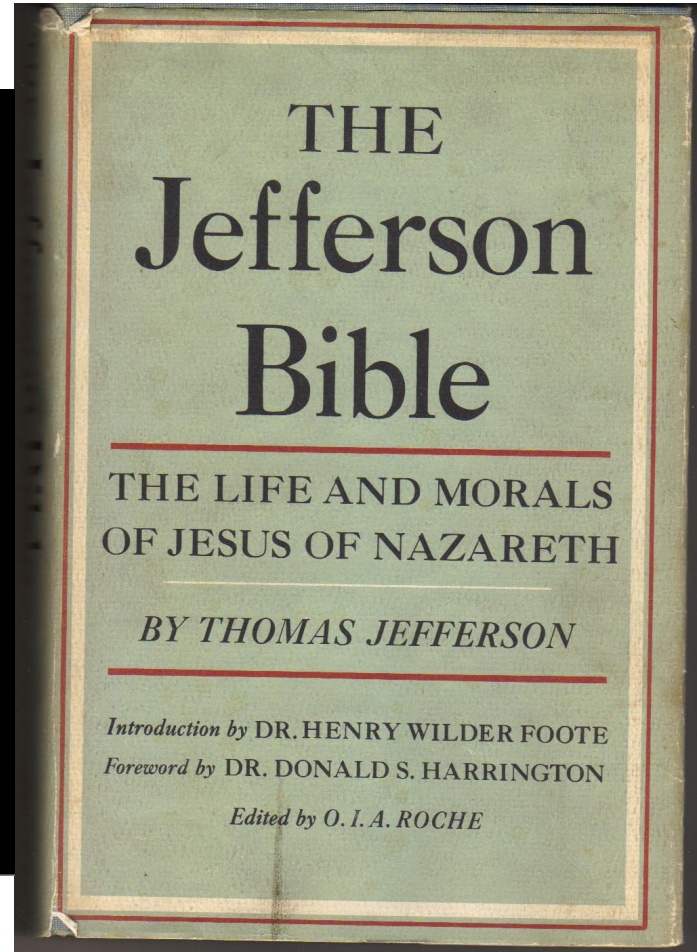

Jn 12:1 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.....**7** Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

Jn 11:5 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus. **6** When he had heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days still in the same place where he was. **7** Then after that saith he to *his* disciples, Let us go into Judaea again. **8** *His* disciples say unto him, Master, the Jews of late sought to stone thee; and goest thou thither again?

Jn 11:17 Then when Jesus came, he found that he had *lain* in the grave four days already. **18** Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off: **19** And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother. **20** Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat *still* in the house. **21** Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. **22** But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give *it* thee.

And Jesus lifted up *his* eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. **42** And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said *it*, that **they may believe** that thou hast sent me.

Grace & Mercy **Jn 1:11** He came unto his own, and his own received him not. **12** But as many as **received him**, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

Jn 11:47 Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this man doeth many miracles. **48** If we let him thus alone, all *men* will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.

Jn 11:49 And one of them, *named* Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all, **50** Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not. **51** And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation; **52** And not for that nation only, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad. **53** Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death.

Jn 11:54 Jesus therefore walked no more openly among the Jews; but went thence unto a country near to the wilderness, into a city called Ephraim, and there continued with his disciples.
