then he arose from the dead to prove He could actually give it to us. Glory! And the Bible says He was seen of 500 witnesses!

I beg you if you haven't already done it, make preparation for that day before you die! Right now! You never know what life will bring you. You could have a fatal accident in the next few moments and go out unprepared. How awful!

Did you know there are two Judgements in the Bible? For sinners, the Great White Throne, where sinners will be judged for their sins (Rev. 20:11-12). And the Judgement Seat of Christ (Rom. 14:10; 2 Cor. 5:10), where believers will be given rewards (Rev. 22:12; Col. 3:20).

At which one would you rather be? If you prepare today by receiving Christ as your Savior and trust His payment for your sins, you won't be at the Great White Throne Judgement! Praise God! I want you to avoid this White Throne Judgement of God by accepting Christ as your Savior.

I want you to be prepared for this before death. I am trying to educate you to be ready. Do not go into Bear Country, not doing so!

I want you to read the Bible verses I have shown you. You can download a free KJV Bible for your phone and read them.

I want you to realize what a dangerous position you are in by not being prepared. We will all travel into bear country (death) sooner or later. "It is appointed unto men once to die, and after this the Judgement."

I want you to say a simple prayer to the God of Heaven stating to Him that you want to be prepared for death, that you realize you're a sinner, and that according to God's rules you deserve Hell, but you don't want to go there, and you trust what Christ did for you on Calvary when He died for you. And that you accept Him as your Savior as best you know-how! (Gal. 2: 16)

When you do, God will seal you with His Holy Spirit (Eph. 1: 12,13). Yes, you will have your bear spray! You'll be prepared.

Now educate yourself some more. You can start by reading the book of Ephesians to find out what else God has done for you. Then continue by finding a church that rightly divides God's Word!

You would welcome salvation coming to your aid!

Many times salvation is in the preparation you made <u>before</u> you meet momma bear!

Hopefully, you have educated yourself as much as possible. You have read books and talked to people who have been there and done that before you. You listened when they told you to put bells on your shoes and pack so you don't walk upon a bear. She will have a chance to hear and avoid you first.

You would have learned to store your food high and away from your campsite... and to always have bear spray! I think you would agree. It would be a great mistake to go into bear country unprepared!

The Bible says, "it is appointed unto men once to die and after this the judgment." (Heb. 9:27)

Please believe me, and prepare for this is a meeting! You will stand before a Holy and Righteous God to give account for your sins.

Once there, you will realize that you are powerless to save yourself! You will be unprepared!

The time to prepare is before death!

God has given us everything we need to educate ourselves in His Word, recorded in the KJV Bible.

There you can read and confirm Romans 3:23, that we are all sinners... But, I'll bet you realized that already, right?

Did you know the Bible teaches there is a penalty for our sin? Even the little ones like lying (Rev. 21:8). See Rom. 6:23, "the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

Wow! When you study that out you will find out that when/if we stand before God as a sinner (and we all are, Rom.3:10, 23), God will punish us according to our sins, and we will wind up in a terrible place called Hell (Rom14:12; 2 Tim 4:11; Jude 1:15 Rev. 20:11-15).

That sounds hopeless! But the story doesn't end there!

The Bible says God loves us and that **He paid** for our sins so we wouldn't have to go to Hell. Yes... He died <u>for</u> us. (Rom. 5:8; 6:23).

Ok... so how does that save us? Please understand. God satisfied His Justice in Christ Jesus. All he asks from us is that we understand and accept it. It's called believing the Gospel.
